2024 Junior Apprentice Program

Thank you for your interest in Historic Cold Spring Village's Junior Apprentice Program. This unique educational opportunity is generously funded by HCSV Foundation and the Friends of Historic Cold Spring Village.

The objective of the Junior Apprentice Program is to educate students ages 11 through 14 about life in the early 1800s by exposing them to the trades, crafts, arts, history and culture from the "Age of Homespun." Applicants choose a craft /trade that they will work on during their sessions. While at Historic Cold Spring Village, all apprentices will be required to wear 19th century period clothing.

Selection for participation in the program is on a first come, first-serve basis and the number of available spaces is limited. No more than six children will be permitted in the session and one child assigned to each trade/craft.

Applicants must be able to show that they have attained a B average or better during the preceding school year. They are also required to write a brief essay and submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher (home schooled applicants may submit a letter of recommendation from a non-related adult).

Applicant's family must be current (2024) members of Historic Cold Spring Village.

The membership form is attached, or can be printed from our website, www.hcsv.org, or you may contact us, and we will mail it to you. To cover the cost of materials used in apprentice projects, a \$150 fee, payable prior to the start of your child's session, is required. Checks can be made payable to Historic Cold Spring Village. *The fee does not need to be paid until you have received notification of your child's acceptance into the program; please do not send the fee with the application.*

Sessions will be held on Thursday and Fridays over four weeks in July and August. Apprentices arrive at the Village Welcome Center at 12 noon, receive a 15-minute break at 2:15 and are finished by 4 pm. They must be picked up by a parent or guardian at Route 9 ticket gate. The dates of the sessions are listed below. Due to the popularity of the program and the limited number of openings available, we ask that applicants who are accepted must be prepared to complete their apprenticeship in full. *If your child cannot participate on all days of their chosen session due to other commitments, please do not submit an application.*
